
To Whom It May Concern:

Recently, I became aware of Nextera's work in large-scale solar project development, through its subsidiary, Kennebec Solar, under consideration in my town of Vassalboro.

As I understand it, this proposed 20MW project would be built on private land with the power sold to a private customer. It would not require a power purchase agreement, or any financial support from the Town. The team from Nextera confirmed that their projects in development will be in compliance with all zoning regulations and state environmental regulations, and also described their own experience in permitting renewable energy projects in Maine. As a former member of the Vassalboro Planning Board, I think a project like this is a perfect fit for our town. Further, as member of a dairy farming family, I understand the value of diversifying one's revenue streams and I believe this type of solar "farming" is poised to benefit towns like my own, and the state as a whole.

Nextera has helped describe how their larger-scale solar projects can be sources of investment and job creation for towns, and also described their relationships with other project host towns throughout Maine. I appreciated learning and hearing more about this proposal. I look forward to further discussions moving forward, and to brainstorming how Vassalboro can work with Nextera to create a mutually beneficial investment.
